## SDAW/WSDLCC SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

- 1. Applicants must belong to a Wisconsin Caller/Cuer Association/Council, which is a member of SDAW and WSDLCC.
  - A. They must have been a member for one year and attended at least half of the meetings during the year prior to requesting a scholarship.
  - B. Verification from the Association/Council President/Chairman must be on the application form.
- 2. Application must be made in writing stating dancing, calling/cueing background, number of year's calling/cueing, and reason for wanting to attend a college and the college they wish to attend.
- 3. No more than the tuition fee, a maximum of \$25.00 will be paid for a Caller/Cuer to attend the college of their choice.
  - A. They will assume all other expenses.
  - B. Checks will be made out to the college.
  - C. The school must be conducted by a recognized Caller/Roundalab teacher/coach.
- 4. Application must be made at least 6 months in advance of school start date. No exceptions. No application will be held over unless monies have been exhausted.
- 5. Application will be sent to Here 'Tis, as a clearing house, and then forwarded without names, to the Selection Committee.
  - A. The Selection Committee will consist of two (2) Caller/Cuer Delegate Couples and two (2) Dancer Delegate Couples, according to the rotation schedule, not to exceed a two-year term.
  - B. Any Caller/Cuer that is on the Committee and would like to apply for a scholarship, may request that their alternate to be on the Committee. (added 5/97)
  - C. The Committee will make this selection at each quarterly SDAW Meeting.
  - D. The Committee will inform Here 'Tis of their selection using code numbers that have been assigned, in the event more than one application has been received.
  - E. The name selected will be sent to the SDAW President to officially inform the recipient(s).
- 6. Application forms may be obtained from the SDAW Contact Secretary, Here 'Tis, their local Association/Council Secretary, or on the SDAW website <a href="https://www.sda-wi.org">www.sda-wi.org</a>.
