

Recognition of Non-Wisconsin Callers/Cuers

Criteria for the Nomination:

The contributions include, but are not limited to

1. Called/Cued at the Wisconsin State Convention 10 or more years within the last 15 years.
2. Called for Wisconsin Square Dance Club dances 5 or more times a year for 10 or more years within the last 15 years.

How are the recipients nominated for the Recognition award and who decides on their selection:

1. Any dancer, caller or cuer from the state of Wisconsin can nominate an individual to be considered as a recipient of the SDAW Recognition Award
2. The SDAW will form a committee comprised of one
 - a. individual/couple from each area to receive nominations. Committee members do not have to be on the SDAW board.
 - b. This committee will review and determine the nominee(s) eligibility for the SDAW Recognition Award.

When will the award be given:

1. The inductees will be recognized at the Annual State Convention
2. The names of the recipients of the award will be printed in all future State Convention souvenir books

What will the Award consist of:

1. A Certificate of Appreciation and a badge produced with the words SDAW Recognition Award with the year presented.

Who is eligible:

1. Any out of state Caller/Cuer that meets the Criteria stated above
